



Avery Substation Project Update

The new Avery Substation will help reduce the risk of outages while meeting the energy needs of existing and new homes and businesses in Windsor, Timnath, Severance and the surrounding communities. Xcel Energy is committed to communicating with you on a regular basis about outages and Avery Substation construction updates.

November 2021 Construction Update

Recently completed activities:

- Installation of underground vaults and wire conduit for electrical distribution equipment along Latham Parkway. Installation of underground equipment along the north side of Weld County Road 76, east of Latham Parkway.
- Rebuild of overhead electric distribution line from CR 5 east to Latham Blvd. There may be additional work in the area regarding cleanup and removal of old structures.

Current activities:

- Equipment delivery and placement continues and may be seen coming on and off County Roads 13 and 76.
- Materials continue being brought to the staging area immediately south of the substation site.
- Installation of underground vaults and wire conduit for electrical distribution equipment along Latham Parkway. Installation of underground equipment along the north side of Weld County Road 76, east of Latham Parkway.
- Installation of underground vaults and wire conduit for electrical distribution equipment from Latham Parkway east to the substation driveway and up west side of the substation driveway to the substation.
- The remaining transmission line foundations will start being installed in the next couple of weeks.
- Construction of the County Road 78 access point and extending road improvements to the north has begun, along with the installation of erosion control measures north of County Road 78.
- Tree removal along the canal on the south side of County Road 78 will be complete by Nov. 30.

Upcoming activities: Transmission line structures will start being installed in early December.

Substation construction began in early 2021 and we anticipate completing the work by Summer 2022. Construction schedules may change. Visit [xcelenergy.com/Avery](https://www.xcelenergy.com/Avery) for up-to-date information.
